Session Structure:

On Ice - 15 min stroking class (power and edge development), 15 min group lesson (focused on core disciplines - Freeskate, Skills, Dance, Synchro, Artistic), min. 1 private or semi private lesson, 45 minutes of skater directed practice

Off Ice - Group class to work on flexibility, cardio, jump development, and more!

Dressing Rooms:

Dressing room assignments will be posted on the electronic TV screens. Only skaters and one assisting adult are permitted in the dressing room to ensure skater safety. All adults must knock before entering.

Coaching Fees

- Additional instruction (private & semi-private lessons) will be billed directly by the coaches the following month. Payment is due 7 days after receiving an invoice or will be subject to 15% interest. If Each coach is a general contractor to LSC and yourself and fees vary from \$8-\$14 plus GST/15 minute lesson depending on the coach. We recommend budgeting for a minimum of one private lesson per skating session. Your skater may also be given an additional semi private lesson to utilize coaches. If you would like to request additional semi- or private lessons, please email coach@leducskating.com.
- If your skater cannot make it to a session please let us know 24hrs in advance. If less notice is given and their lesson slot cannot be filled you will still be charged the applicable lesson fees
- When applicable, freeski and artistic program music cutting is completed by the coaches and fees range from \$25 - \$50/program

Equipment:

- Well-fitted skates with ankle support
- Gloves, jacket/sweater without a hood, and athletic pants
- Water bottle
- Hair ties to ensure hair is out of face

Skate Maintenance:

- Skates should be sharpened every two months in Edmonton at United Cycle, ProSkate or 111th Street Skate Sharpening

STAR Assessments:

STAR Assessments provide the structure for excelling in all areas of figure skating. STAR 1-5 Freeskate, Dance, and Artistic assessments and STAR 1-Gold Skills assessments are conducted by the coaching team. When your skater is ready for one of these assessments you will be notified via email so you can pay a \$12 assessment fee through our website. Assessments will be conducted during lesson time and skills lessons are allotted two slots. STAR 6-Gold Freeskate, Dance, and Artistic assessments are assessed at Assessment days, more info will be shared via email throughout the season.
